

Proclamation for Special Election

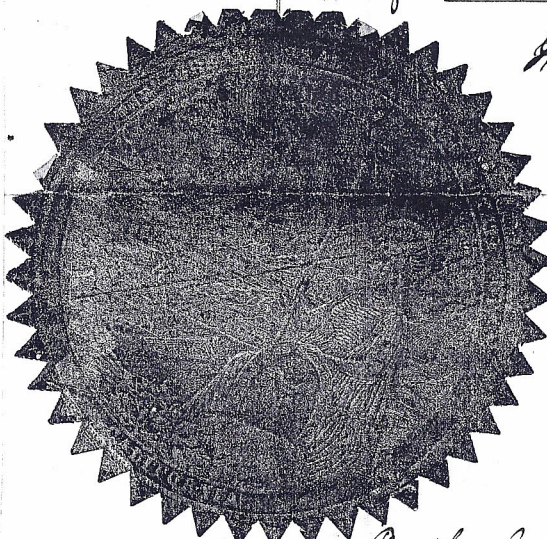
A special election will be held on Thursday, the seventh day of February, A.D. 1878 in the Ninth Senatorial District, composed of the county of Glenn, for the election of one Senator for that District to the Legislature of this state, to fill the vacancy in the office of Senator aforesaid, occurring by the death of the Hon Nathan Porter.

"And I do hereby offer a reward of one hundred dollars for the arrest and conviction of any and every person violating any of the provisions of Title IV, Part I of the Penal Code; such rewards to be paid until the total amount hereafter expended for the purpose reaches the sum of ten thousand dollars.
